What is Clerk Work?

- Clerk Work is a three-year project of Run for Something, a progressive political action committee.
- The project's goal is to recruit leftist candidates to run for state and local elected offices that exert control over America's election process.
- These offices include:
 - county probate judges and registrars
 - county election board members
 - county clerks
 - state secretaries of state, and more.

There are 35 states that elect these election administrators that are being targeted by Clerk Work.¹





The Sinister Motive Behind Clerk Work

- A Clerk Work memo to donors described its goal as "taking over our election administration infrastructure at the local level."²
- But election administrators are expected to do their jobs objectively and free from political influence.
